Tips for Coaching

Here a couple of coaching tips to keep you stretched and focused:

- ✿ Establish clear guidelines for the relationship and coaching process on the front end. Don't assume anything.
- ✿ Notice the meaning that the coachee (and you) attribute to the challenges or hindrances that you encounter. Try asking, "Does the meaning that you have given this situation empower you or disempower you?"
- ✿ Challenge your coachee to imagine reaching their goals. "Check your goals on a regular basis – each day take some time to really *try on* what it will be like when you achieve them.

What will you do?

What will you feel?

What will you say?"

- ✿ Always conclude with an affirmation of action: "As a result of today's appointment, what are you committing to do?"
